As we draw near to the end of the academic year that has seen the resumption of National GCSE examinations, we take stock and reflect on how well our students have coped. I'd also like to recognise and give thanks to the hard work and dedication of staff and students alike as well as the continued support offered by yourselves.

National GCSE results day is on **Thursday 25th August 2022** and results will be available to collect from 9am – 12 noon. We also advise all students come into school on the day so that they can meet some of our 6th Form enrolment team and other career services.

Year 11 enrolment into Bluecoat Sixth Form will take place on Thursday 25th at Bluecoat Wollaton Academy in IT05 and the Library. Enrolment staff will also be available at the Sixth Form site on Maid Marian Way between 9am – 2pm of Friday 26th, offering guidance and support.

For more information on next steps once students have received their results, they can also contact the National Exam Results Helpline, run by the **National Careers Service**. They can be called on 0800 100 900. Lines are open from 08:00 to 22:00, 7 days a week. Calls are free from landlines and most mobile numbers.

A full breakdown of the results and the grades will also be available on Go4Schools after this event should your child be unable to attend to collect results in person. Please note we are unable to give results out to anyone other than the student themselves. There is also a form available on the website should your child need to send a representative to collect these results. Anyone other than the student collecting the results will need to bring in the completed form and photographic evidence to collect the results.
