Year 11 | October Half-Term Targeted Support Sessions

Dear Parent/Carer,

In order to support students to achieve their maximum potential in their studies prior to their mock exams in November, we intend to offer a number of additional sessions to provide students with access to specialist instruction and support.

Attendance at these sessions is voluntary, however we would ask you to strongly encourage your child to attend appropriate sessions if they are able to. The timetable for these sessions is included with this letter. Some sessions are targeted at students who we feel would benefit most from attending them, whilst others are open to all students that study those subjects. **Students must sign up for these in advance – students who have not booked will be unable to attend.** In order to register to attend sessions, **students must be signed up in advance via Reach More Parents** (<https://www.bluecoatwollaton.co.uk/parents/reach-more-parents/>). Places at sessions are limited, and whilst we would encourage parents to book early to avoid disappointment, please only register for sessions that your child will definitely be able to attend to avoid others missing out.

The school site will only be open on these days to those students who have booked a place, and **access will be through the main reception entrance on Sutton Passeys Crescent only**, with students required to sign in. Students are not expected to attend in uniform, but are expected to be punctual. Students arriving more than 15 minutes after the start of a session will be sent home. Students may wish to bring a packed lunch on any day that they are attending both morning and afternoon sessions as the dining hall will not be open.
